


Classroom Spelunking

- 1. Use butcher paper to make a cave. Get creative!
 - 2. Bring flashlights or headlamps (Check Oriental Trading or ask parents to send in)
- 3. Put pillows and books in your cave.
 - 4. If your cave is big, have everyone hold on to a rope and travel together in to your cave for a special flashlight story time
 - 5. For smaller caves, let kids take turns entering with flashlights.
 Read about cave facts then come out and share discoveries with the class

Have a fun adventure!


Script for leading your class spelunking trip:


1) Pretend to get a phone call from the National Speleological Society.


"A new cave has appeared? And you want us to explore it? Okay, we are on it!"


- 2) Tell the class that they are been called for a special spelunking duty, and that they need to report back with all the facts they find. But they must follow safety protocol!
- --Nobody goes caving alone
- --Everyone holds on to the life line rope (have any kind of string long enough for everyone to hold together)
- --Bring a flashlight, lantern, or headlamp
- 3) Once you are in the cave, read CAVES and discuss what kind of cave your classroom cave is.


